Get Your Captain's License

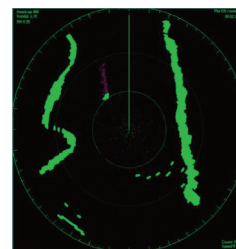
Between the USCG requirements for sea time, physicals, applications and examination,
