1. Character of Exhibits: Management may rent and license space for an exhibit related to the recreational maritime industry and related activities, such as waterfront living. Management shall have the right, in its sole discretion to move or remove any display or item of display that does not comply with the theme of the Nautical Flea Market. Only those products specifically listed on Exhibitor's contract will be permitted.
2. License and Term: Licensee may enter the event and its leased space at 0600 on the date of the event shown on the contract and shall have its display completed by opening time. The space shall be maintained in good order and fully manned at all times the event is open to the public. Licensee may not begin to dismantle its display until after the hour of closing on the last day of the event. Licensee shall keep its display and materials completely within its allotted space at all times. Licensee may not permit any vehicle to remain on the event grounds unless an integral part of the display. Licensee shall have all of its display removed and its space and surrounding areas clear and clean by 8 PM on the day of closing of the event.
3. Assignment: Licensee may not assign or sublet its space without prior written permission of management.
4. Insurance and Liability: Management carries no insurance for the benefit of Licensee. Licensee shall be solely responsible for its own insurance. Management and the Naval Academy Athletic Association and their officers, agents and employees shall not be responsible or liable to Licensee or its employees.
5. Indemnification of Management: Licensee shall at all times indemnify Management, Naval Academy Athletic Association and their officers, agents and employees against all actions, claims, demands, liabilities and damages that may be imposed upon or incurred by them or any of them as a consequence of, or arising out of, any act, default or omission on the part of Licensee, its officers, agents, employees or invitees.
6. Cleanup: Licensee shall keep its assigned space and any public areas around its space broom clean at all times. No holes may be made and no paint or other substance shall be placed on the grounds by Exhibitor.
7. Cancellation: If, for any reason, Management cancels the event, Licensee waives any and all claims for damages and agrees that receipt of a refund of the fee paid by Licensee less a pro rata share of Management expenses shall be in full satisfaction.
8. Rules and Regulations: Management shall have the right to make all rules and regulations governing the event. All rules promulgated after execution of this agreement shall be furnished to Licensee and shall be binding upon Licensee at that time.
9. Default: In the event of failure of Licensee to perform under this agreement, Management shall have the right to deny Licensee admission to the event, to remove Licensee's exhibits, or to pursue any other claim permitted by law.
10. Miscellaneous: The relationship between Management and Licensee is that of independent contractors, and not as agency or partnership. This document, the event Rules and Regulations, Licensee's application, and the set up bulletin constitute the entire agreement, unless in writing and signed by Management. The laws of Maryland shall apply and suit may be brought against Management only in the Courts of Anne Arundel County.
